The contest is divided into a walk-trot division (for only those who are eligible to compete in walk trot classes), junior division (under 13 as of 12/1/05) and a senior division (14-21 as of 12/1/05). At the end of the contest, each contestant's results will be totaled. The first place Senior winner will qualify for the Grand National Youth of the Year contest, and win a cash award of \$300.00 (\$100 given at the time of the Circle J contest, and the remainder given prior to leaving for the National contest). The winner of the Grand National contest receives a four-week trip to the country of their choice. The reserve Senior winner will be awarded \$100, to be awarded at the time of the Circle J contest. The Junior division winner will be awarded \$50, to be awarded at the time of the Circle J contest, the Reserve Junior winner will be awarded \$25, again awarded at the time of the Circle J contest. The AMHA Youth of the Year contest is one of the most prestigious contests you can win in the Morgan breed just taking part is an example of your commitment to the Morgan Make the most of this opportunity to learn about Morgans and to demonstrate your knowledge. - *The test will be made up of fill in the blank, multiple choice, matching, and true /false questions.
- *Walk/Trot will have 50 Questions, Junior 100, and the Senior test will have 250 Questions.
- *There will not be an alternate time to take this exam
- *After the days events are completed, you will have an opportunity to look over your corrected test. An answer key will be made available to contestants. Any questions or concerns with how your test was scored or totaled need to be addressed at that time.
